# PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

Welcome back! So great to have all our students back. For now parents and carers must remain offsite until the Department updates its operational guidelines. Anyone coming in for preschool drop offs/pick up or to visit the office or for an appointment must sign in using the QR code. You can see an overview of our Covid Safety Plan below.

Thank you for your support during the remote learning period. It was a very difficult time for you - we understand this and working with our families closely was the best way to support students and our parents and carers. I am sure you will agree that teachers and staff went to great lengths to make sure students have high quality learning to complete at home, with support via regular phone calls and Seesaw.

Information keeps changing about what would happen if we have a Covid case on the school site. I think its best to hope this does not occur but if it does, I will share information at the time so it is correct.

#### Riverwood PS Covid Safety Plan

Here is an overview of the plans we have in place to keep everyone safe from Covid.

#### Coming Into School

- Anyone coming to school must be completely well with no signs of illness before coming into school – please stay home and get tested if you have any Covid-19 symptoms (including fever, sore throat, runny nose, cough, headache).
- Any student or staff member showing symptoms will be sent home.
- Unfortunately, parents and carers are not allowed into the school for now. There are a few exceptions:

- Preschool parents who must drop off and collect children to preschool must sign in using the QR code at preschool. Please show the green tick to an educator.
- If you need to purchase a uniform you may come into the office. You will need to sign in using the QR code at the gate and show the green tick to the camera.
- If a meeting with a member of staff is needed, you need to make an appointment first. You must sign in using the QR code at the gate and show the green tick to the camera when you come in for your appointment.

### Drop Off and Pick Ups

- We need to do this a bit better than we have done and avoid crowding around the gate.
- Everyone needs to be 1.5 metres apart from each other on the footpath – not on the road. You can wait on the other side of Union Street.
- You can wait away from the gate and once people move, you can come closer.
- Please follow instructions from staff. They will ask you to move if you are not following the advice mentioned here.
- We will be calling students to the front gate on the microphone.

#### Important things across the school day:

- Students are strongly encouraged to bring and wear a mask.
- All staff members will be wearing masks. All staff members are vaccinated.
- Students will not mingle across their groups inside or outside.
- All classrooms will be well ventilated.
- We have carbon dioxide monitors in rooms helping teachers to monitor the quality of air inside classrooms.

- Students will be washing hands across the day and follow strong hygiene routines.
- Students will not be sharing resources.
- Extra cleaning will happen across the school day.
- We will try and encourage social distancing.

#### Updates:

- Our regular after school program is on hold for now-taekwondo will be on Fridays for all grades. Sydney FC will be doing 4 weeks of soccer on Tuesdays. A frisbee program for K-6 will also start soon on Thursdays for 4 weeks. Our music program with The Song Room will also commence in Week 5. All these amazing programs for our students at no cost to our families!
- Maria our speech therapist resumed her program last week - great to get this support happening.
- Miss Maria our learning support officer has returned to RPS to finish the year off back with us - welcome back!
- We have a new social worker joining us for Wednesdays - welcome to Hana.
- Ms Kennedy's leave continues and Mrs McWaters will be on K/1K for now.
- Our playground upgrade is now complete and the temporary fencing will soon be moved.
- We have had around 8 students leave during the remote learning period and we have about the same number of new students - welcome to our new students and families!

#### ROAD AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

- Illegally stopping in the bus stops you should know that the fine for stopping at the bus stop is \$344 and the loss of 2 demerit points. The biggest problem with people who stop in the bus stops is that it makes the area at the front of the school very unsafe.
- Seat belts Just a reminder that everyone in a car is required to wear a seat belt. Younger children must also be in the correct child seat and be belted in. The fine is \$344 and the loss of 3 demerit points.
- Breaking the law just a reminder that the council
  officers and police are patrolling the area around the
  school and will be issuing fines. Once they take your
  photo you will receive the fine in the mail.
- Repeat Offenders Again some parents/carers continue to make unsafe decisions. Staff members will be providing you with a flyer when you are being unsafe, which explains the fine for the offence. We take student safety seriously and are ready to help educate you about how unsafe it is to break the parking and road laws. As well as how expensive the fines are. I don't want it to take the death or serious injury of a pedestrian for everyone to take this issue more seriously.

- Crossing upgrade very soon work will start to upgrade our crossing. There will also be fencing installed on Union St and Pennsylvania Rd which will stop people unsafely crossing the road as it will mean people will have to use the crossing to cross the street.
- Construction work opposite the school the site across from the school is going to be cleared very soon. An apartment complex is being build there with 51 apartments. This will have a fairly big impact during construction, with large trucks moving in and out, as well as less parking spaces being available in the area with all the construction workers parking nearby. We are working closely with the council, owners of the site and the workers to ensure things are as safe as possible.

Just a reminder that all students should be in full school uniform - this includes school hats. Some students have school hats but are wanting to wear their cool fashionable hats - this is not allowed unfortunately.

As some students have grown and may have lost their hats - there will be a sale for the next 2 weeks. All uniform items will be 25% off.

We will be flexible this week only with uniforms. If students do not come in full uniform from next week, parents/carers will be contacted. Thanks for your support in ensuring your children leave for school in the correct uniform. Students need to hear this from both us at school, and you.
